2 SECONDMENTS

3 DELEGATION OF AUTHORITY TO CHIEF CONSTABLE: USE OF POLICE AUTHORITY PREMISES BY OUTSIDE ORGANISATIONS

There is currently no delegated authority for the Chief Constable, or any officer of the Police Authority, to allow appropriate outside organisations to use police premises.

It is therefore proposed this authority be delegated to Northumbria Police staff, acting with the consent of the Chief Constable. Staff will permit use of Police Authority premises only when suitable premises are available, and there will be no interference with the operational requirements of the force.

RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that delegated authority is granted to Northumbria Police staff, acting with the Chief Constable's consent, to allow appropriate outside organisations use of Police Authority premises, when suitable premises are available and there will be no interference with the operational requirements of the force.
