1 SECONDMENTS

**3 VISIT TO BERLIN, GERMANY - CHIEF INSPECTOR N MINTO
(OPERATIONAL SUPPORT DEPARTMENT)**

Chief Inspector Minto has been selected to attend the European Roads Policing Conference, to be held in Berlin, Germany, between 28 and 31 October 2003.

The Conference will facilitate access to evaluated initiatives and new tools and resources in roads policing. It will also allow Chief Inspector Minto to network with others in the same field and to compare investigative techniques.

The total cost to the Authority will be approximately £814.

RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that approval be given for Chief Inspector Minto to visit Berlin, to attend the European Roads Policing Conference, between 28 and 30 October 2003.
